

GUIDELINES FOR DELEGATES AND ALTERNATES TO 2020 RNC

<u>The Republican National Convention will be held August 24th- 27th, 2020 in Charlotte, NC.</u>

Anyone wishing to run as a delegate or alternate must submit a \$150.00 qualifying fee and complete the qualifying form at lagop.com/delegate.

Qualifying dates: Friday, January 3, 2020 - Friday, February 28, 2020

- Candidates for delegate or alternate delegate must be a registered Republican as of November 2019 and complete the required forms of the Louisiana Republican Party.
- If a delegate or alternate wishes to change before the end of qualifying, they must submit an additional \$150.00 fee and a new qualifying form. You cannot change places once qualifying has closed.
- If elected as a delegate, you are responsible for paying the costs of your transportation to and from Charlotte, your lodging and between \$500 \$1,000 activity fee.


After completing qualifying form and receiving initial approval, in order to be considered as an officially endorsed candidate for delegate or alternate delegate, the following guidelines apply:

- Candidates for delegate must: (1) recruit and organize 50 precinct captains, in accordance with precinct captain guidelines, or (2) Become a member of the Finance Committee.
- Candidates for alternate delegate must: (1) recruit and organize 25 precinct captains, in accordance with precinct captain guidelines, or (2) Become a member of the Finance Committee.

For Republican elected public officials, the requirements are reduced by 20%.

If you are not elected as a delegate or alternate, you will be able to qualify as a guest to the convention. Information about qualifying as a guest can be found at lagop.com/delegate.





LOUISIANA DELEGATE OR ALTERNATE TO THE 2020 RNC

GUIDELINES FOR THE RECRUITMENT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

Below are the guidelines on serving as a Louisiana Delegate or Alternate to the Republican National Convention through the recruitment or finance committee.

It is your goal to:

- (1) To recruit, train and organize Precinct Captains for the 2020 election
- (2) To become a member of the 2020 RNC Finance Committee


Recruitment Committee:

This step towards serving as a Louisiana Delegate or Alternate to the Republican National Convention, for those wishing to serve on a Recruitment Committee.

- **1. Serve as Precinct Captain for your own precinct** It is important for you to gain personal experience as a Precinct Captain while you ask others to do so. The elections this year provide a great opportunity to do just that. You will have the opportunity to see first-hand the response of voters in your precinct to Republican candidates.
- 2. Recruit Precinct Captains by conducting 3 Precinct Captain meetings in

your area- Find a venue and host 3 meetings in your area to make an informational presentation to potential precinct captains. You will need to personally call, email and text at least 100 of your friends in the area. More is better. Facebook is a great place to organize events. You should invite at least 200 friends on the event page. Your goal is to have a turnout of at least 75 and to have at least half sign up to be a precinct captain.





Prior to each meeting, you must work to insure a good turnout. This will include inviting friends and family on Facebook, calling them personally to remind them to attend the meeting, sending emails to friends and other methods available to you to insure a good turnout.

At the meeting you will make an informational presentation explaining what is necessary to be a precinct captain. You will also provide cards foreach individual to complete to record each person's name, address, cell phone and email, as well as any notes each individual may like to include.

After the meeting, you will send the information on each individual to Cindy North, who will forward to each person their precinct information.


3. Follow up with each precinct captain recruit to answer questions and

<u>encourage-</u> The information that we provide can sometimes be overwhelming. It's important that each precinct captain understand that he is part of a team. This can best be accomplished by you keeping in touch with the precinct captains. Call each precinct captain and encourage them to focus on a short list of neighborhoods within the precinct, preferably near their own home. Or just call and touch base and ask if there is any way you can help. It's important to keep open lines of communication!

Experienced precinct captains as a result of your first meeting will be helpful in working with precinct captains you recruit in later meetings.

4. Get out the Vote for the Louisiana CaucusesCaptains should vote in the Louisiana Caucuses on March 28th. Each Precinct
Captain should contact each of his identified Trump Household to vote also.
Each identified Trump Household should call 3 other households to encourage them to vote.





5.Get out the Vote for the Louisiana Republican Presidential Preference

<u>Primary-</u> Precinct Captains and identified voters should do the same for the Primary on April 4th.

6.Attend the State Convention- All at large delegates and alternates will be elected, and all district delegates and alternates will be confirmed at the state convention on Saturday, April 18th. In addition, immediately following the convention, there will be a meeting of delegates and alternates to the National Convention. Alternates may vote, but only in the absence of a delegate.

You, the candidate for Delegate or Alternate must serve as the primary contact with your precinct captains. Our office will help in supporting Precinct Captains by dealing with matters beyond your scope.


Finance Committee:

This step toward serving as a Louisiana Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the Republican National Convention, for those wishing to serve on a Finance Committee.

It is your goal as a Delegate to qualify as a member of the Finance Committee by contributing or raising \$25,000 for the Louisiana Republican Party; or as an Alternate to qualify as a member of the Finance Committee by raising or contributing \$12,500 to the Louisiana Republican Party.

In order to do this, you must first complete the forms required by the Republican Party of Louisiana. The initial forms may be completed online. You will receive a unique donation URL and contribution forms. A contribution form must accompany each contribution.





All contributions must be either by check or credit card. Cash contributions will not be accepted. Checks must be made payable to the Republican Party of Louisiana. Contributions may be from individuals, corporations, partnerships, a political committee, or an LLC. Contributions will be accepted until April 18th.

The Republican Party of Louisiana will be conducting many fundraising events throughout 2020 and your donors will be eligible to attend these events in accordance with criteria which will be established for each event.
